


DECLARATION OF GLORIA MEEKS

1. My name is Gloria Meeks, I am 69 years old and I reside at [REDACTED]
2. On or about August 10, 2006, I was taking a bath in my home. I was preparing to go to a doctor appointment and a friend was going to drive me. The friend was waiting for me in my living room. It was around 8:30 a.m.
3. While I was in my bathroom getting ready, two men knocked at my door and without identifying themselves, told my friend they were there to speak to me.
4. My friend told them to wait a minute at the door and he would let me know they were there to see me.
5. Apparently these investigators then went to the window of my house and peeped into my bathroom window, not once but twice, while I was in my bathroom drying off from my bath. I screamed. The two men then disappeared from my window.
6. I quickly got dressed and came out to where my friend was and explained what happened. The two men were at my front door and I yelled at them for scaring me by peeping into my bathroom window. They apologized and offered that they thought they were looking into my kitchen window.
7. I did then meet with these two persons, [REDACTED], but I did continue to tell them how angry I was that they looked in at me while I was in the bathroom and not clothed.
8. I am still mad and upset by what they did, and I feel as if my privacy was invaded by them.
