Recent media reports indicate that the Grand Jury on which you serve is currently examining possible criminal activity by Attorney General Ken Paxton. We have enclosed information relating to Mr. Paxton's dealings in the development of the Collin County Central Appraisal District.

You will find attached a letter outlining a series of transactions that lead to a reasonable suspicion that Ken Paxton and his associates could have engaged in criminal activity. Also enclosed is a jump drive containing the supporting documentation.

The public information available from county and city sources paints a disturbing picture of insider dealing and manipulation of public resources for private gain. We are hopeful that the Grand Jury will use the full range of its powers to investigate whether and what sort of criminal activity was involved in procuring the land and zoning changes that allowed the Collin County Central Appraisal District to be built in its current location.
